System Requirements

Students, staff, and faculty need the following to access EduRisk online courses:

Hardware

- 1024 x 768 (or higher) screen resolution
- 256K (or higher) Internet connection
- Sound card and speakers (depending on courses accessed)

Software

- The latest version of Adobe Flash Player
- Adobe Reader
